



POSITION SUMMARY

Under the supervision of the Chief Quality Officer (CQO), the Quality, Safety, and Infection Control Coordinator works to ensure high levels of safety and quality at Hidalgo Medical Services (HMS). The Quality, Safety, and Infection Control Coordinator works to ensure that HMS complies with local, state, and federal regulations, accrediting body requirements, and HMS Chief Executive Officer (CEO) and Board of Directors-approved policies and procedures.

- 4. Under the direction of the CQO, coordinates various aspects of the HMS Safety program to ensure high levels of process and system performance.
- 5. Under the guidance of the Infection Control Registered Nurse, reviews, updates, and helps support IPC processes, procedures, and policies for compliance.
- 6. Under the guidance of the Infection Control Registered Nurse, monitors and reviews data related to IPC and safety practices, identifying opportunities for performance improvement.
- 7. Under the guidance of the Infection Control Registered Nurse, conducts ongoing surveillance of IPC and safety processes to ensure safe practices and compliance with HMS policies and procedures.
- 8. Demonstrated interest in rural and community health
- 9. Commitment to the highest ethical standards of the profession
- 10. Ability to maintain confidentiality and discretion as a rule
- 11. Ability to meet specified deadlines and manage time effectively
- 12. Exhibit skills in comprehending, interpreting, and completing delegated tasks efficiently
- 13. Self-starter; must have the ability to work independently and follow up on all work assignments given
- 14. Ability to multi-task, prioritize, and work under pressure without losing sight of objectives
